Disposal of Household Garbage



Types of Garbage	Combustible Garbage	Incombustible Garbage: Metallic Items	Incombustible Garbage: Glass and Ceramics	Oversized Garbage (Items too large to fit in a bag)

Leave the garbage out for collection	Twice a week	Once or twice a month	Once or twice a month	4 times a year

Only certain bags can be used. Tie up the bag. Tape cannot be used. Wrap up sharp items in paper.				




Cans 	Items including the aluminum or steel mark  <input type="checkbox"/> Juice cans <input type="checkbox"/> Liquor cans	Wash the inside then separate the aluminum and the steel.	<input type="checkbox"/> Spray cans <input type="checkbox"/> Gas cylinders for cassette stoves * Dispose of these as hazardous waste.
Bottles 	<input type="checkbox"/> Juice bottles <input type="checkbox"/> Liquor bottles	Wash the inside and separate into: <input type="checkbox"/> colorless <input type="checkbox"/> brown <input type="checkbox"/> other colors.	<input type="checkbox"/> Broken bottles <input type="checkbox"/> Greasy bottles <input type="checkbox"/> Glass cups * Dispose of these as glass and ceramics garbage.
Plastic Bottles 	<input type="checkbox"/> Plastic bottles of juice and condiments	Wash the inside and remove the cap and label	<input type="checkbox"/> Plastic bottles that are still dirty inside * Dispose of these as combustible garbage.

White trays 		Wash then remove seals and labels.	<input type="checkbox"/> Trays that remain dirty are combustible garbage. <input type="checkbox"/> Cup noodle containers <input type="checkbox"/> Natto trays * Dispose of as container packaging plastics.
Waste cooking oil	<input type="checkbox"/> Tempura or salad oil, etc. used at home	Remove oil debris etc., transfer to a plastic bottle and fasten with the cap.	
Styrofoam 	<input type="checkbox"/> Items used to wrap goods, etc.	<input type="checkbox"/> Items that cannot be cleaned are disposed of as combustible garbage <input type="checkbox"/> Cut up large objects.	
Newspapers Magazines/ Flyers Cardboard Paper cartons 	<input type="checkbox"/> Bind each type with string. <input type="checkbox"/> Put out confectionery boxes, photocopy paper, tissue boxes, etc. inserted between magazines, etc. <input type="checkbox"/> Cut open and wash before disposing of them. <input type="checkbox"/> Bind with string before disposal. <input type="checkbox"/> Dispose along with magazines if the inside is aluminum or if the contents are less than 500 ml.		Please note: Do not leave garbage out in the rain. <input type="checkbox"/> Leather goods <input type="checkbox"/> Underwear <input type="checkbox"/> Cushions <input type="checkbox"/> Balls of yarn <input type="checkbox"/> Dirty clothes, and <input type="checkbox"/> Stuffed toys should be disposed of as combustible garbage. <input type="checkbox"/> Carpets and <input type="checkbox"/> Bedding should be disposed of as oversized garbage.





Items That Cannot Be Thrown Out

Means of Disposal	Date and Place To Leave Garbage Out
Affix an oversized garbage sticker. ¥200 each 	4 times a year The day and place for disposal differs depending on where you live, so refer to the garbage collection schedule.

Corrugated iron, bedding, cushions and carpets	Smaller than 1 m ³ per type. 1 pc
Spring mats / Pianos / Organs / Electronic organs / Solar water heaters	3 pcs

Computers		Apply to Renet Japan 
Anything with a needle attached	Hypodermic needles 	Return to hospital or pharmacy
