

Only certain bags can be used. Tie up the bag. Wrap up sharp items in paper.

Tape cannot be used.

Oversized Garbage

Means of Disposal

Date and Place To Leave Garbage Out

Affix an oversized garbage sticker.

¥200 each



4 times a year

The day and place for disposal differs depending on where you live, so refer to the garbage collection schedule.

Types of Oversized Garbage	Number
Bicycles / Furniture / Beds / Sinks / Gas stoves / Boilers / Bath boilers / Accordion curtains / Golf equipment / Ski equipment / Strollers / Surfboards	1 pc
Corrugated iron, bedding, cushions and carpets	Smaller than 1 m³ per type. 1 pc
Spring mats / Pianos / Organs / Electronic organs / Solar water heaters	3 pcs
